Exhibitor benefits

1. Single exhibition table, with two chairs and power supply (Schuko socket (230 V_{AC} / 50 Hz).
2. Free-of-charge attendance at the 19th iCC for two persons.

Exhibitor requirements

1. Payment of the fee for attending the exhibition and conference, prior to the event.
2. A cancelation of a registration for the tabletop exhibition, received at CiA office, prior to January 29, 2027, is free of charge. Starting with January 29, 2027, the entire exhibitor fee is charged.
3. Advertisement of the event, in exhibitor's media channels (provide evidence).

Safety requirements

1. Tabletop exhibitors are responsible for the safety of their products. Unsafe products will not be exhibited. The decision regarding the safety of products rests solely with CiA.
2. Tabletop exhibitors take care that there are no touchable voltages; if parts in motion are exhibited, these parts need to be in a housing.
3. CiA shall not assume any responsibility or liability for damage to, or loss of, exhibits, regardless of the cause.

Cancellation policy

1. In case of your cancellation of participation, till the submission deadline given in this document, or in case of providing an unsafe product that thus cannot be exhibited, a charge in the full amount of the costs mentioned is invoiced.
2. In case the tabletop exhibition is cancelled (e.g. due to lack of interest), CiA is entitled to withdraw from the contract, till four weeks prior to the event, without any compensation.

Financial obligations

CiA GmbH is entitled to withdraw from the contract, if you do not meet the financial obligations arising from this contract, and a 14-day grace period set by CiA GmbH is not met either. In case you breach the contract, CiA is also entitled, in addition to withdrawing from the contract to charge you the price for the tabletop exhibition as lump-sum compensation. The CiA's right to demand further compensation remains unaffected.
